MoD homes in Wiltshire on the market after refurbishment

A new batch of surplus MoD homes has gone on the market in Wiltshire after a refurbishment.

The properties on Drakes Avenue and Sarum Drive have been launched by Annington as part of the next phase of its collection of homes in the area.

This comes after other former MoD homes in Redhorn Gardens and Marlborough Close were unveiled earlier this year.

The latest group of properties are available to buy from £225,000 and have been “lightly refurbished” since housing members of the armed forces.

Annington became one of the UK’s largest private residential property owners by purchasing almost 60,000 homes from the MoD.

Head of sales and marketing Louise Saunders said: “It’s wonderful to be able to return to Devizes to provide another selection of well-needed homes for local first-time buyers and families.

“Buyers can now purchase in a well-established area with mature green space and plenty of square footage at an attractive price.”

Samantha Brazell, of selling agent Allen & Harris, added: “Devizes is a particularly popular spot; it has a lot going on with great commuter links to the surrounding areas.

“These homes are located in an established neighbourhood, which means you’re getting a great price when compared with a new build, for somewhere that is already integrated into the community.”
